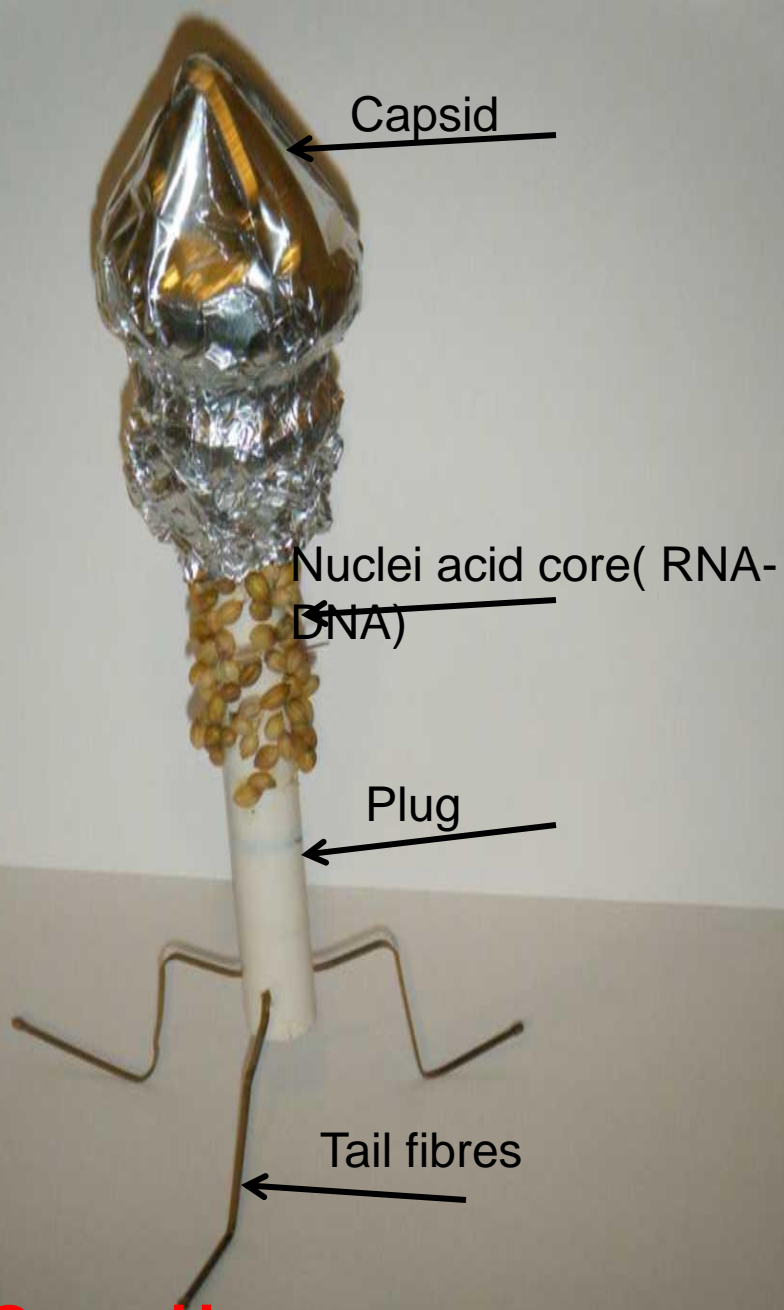

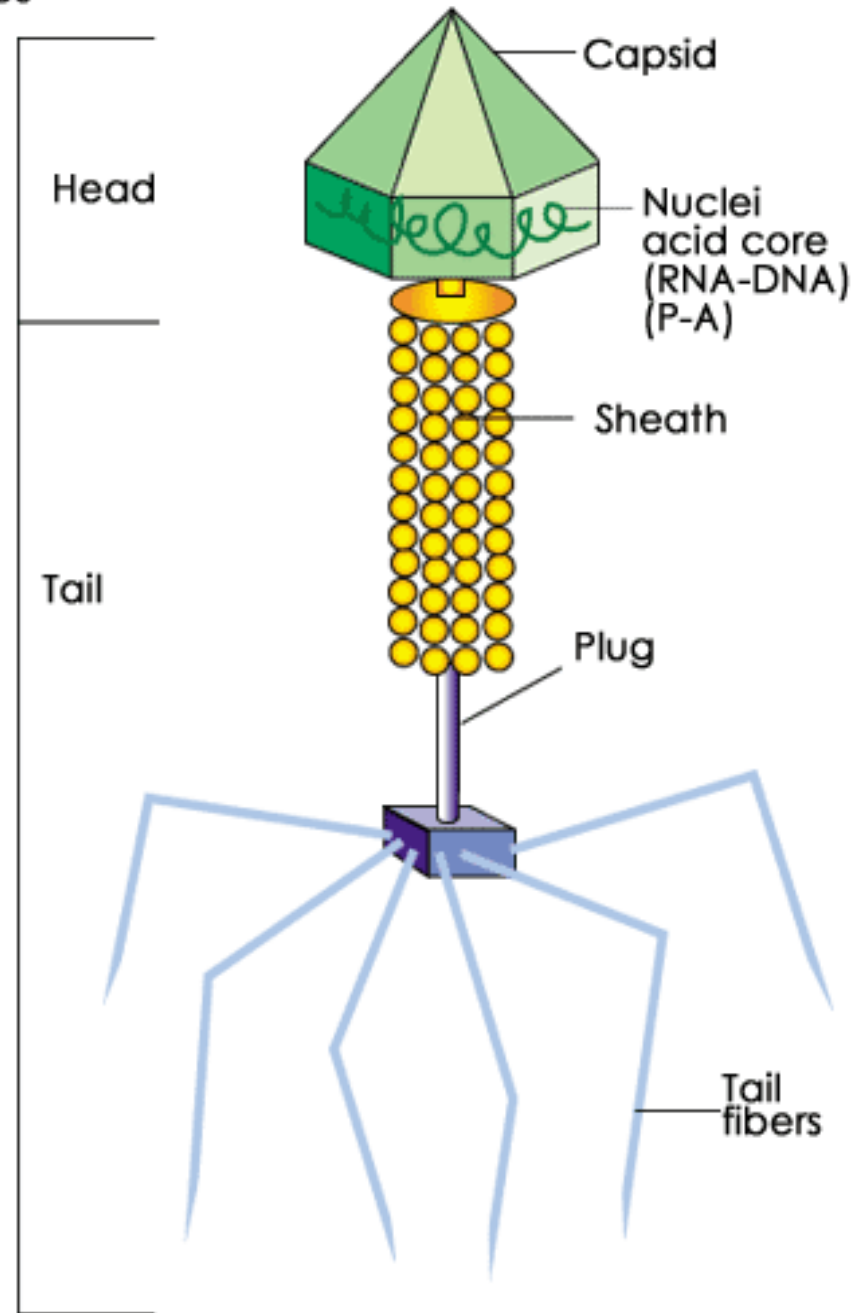

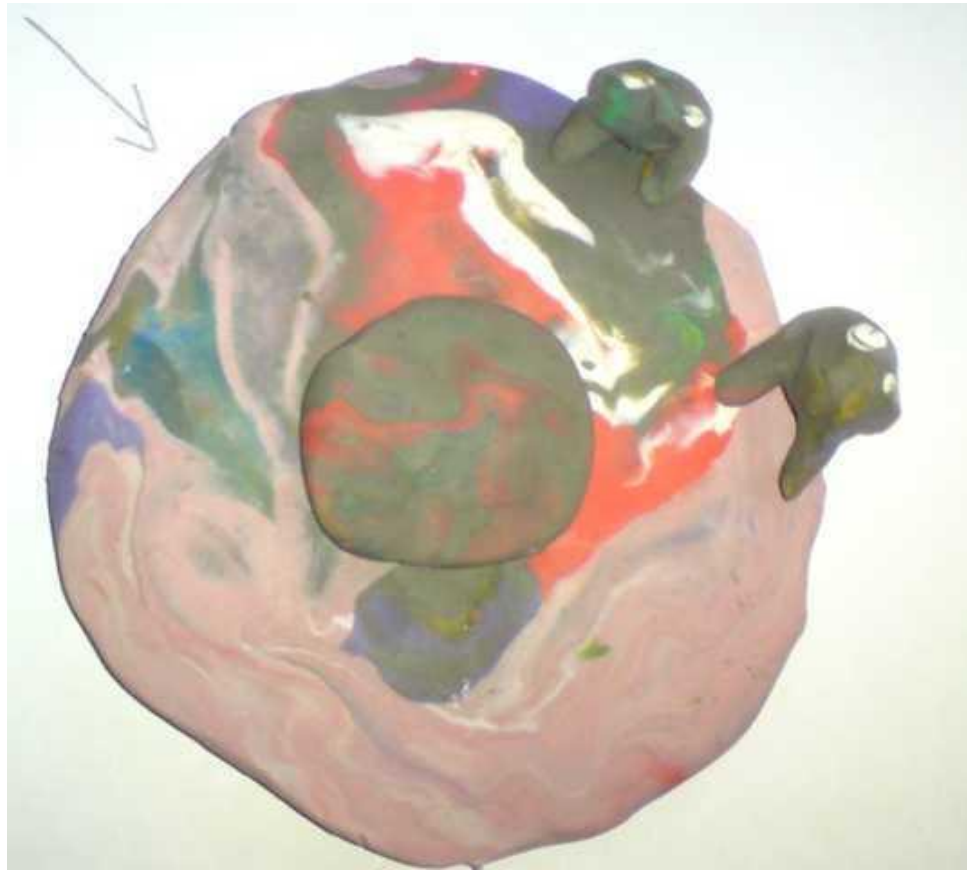
The virus latches onto the cell.

The viruses scatter to find other cells to infect.

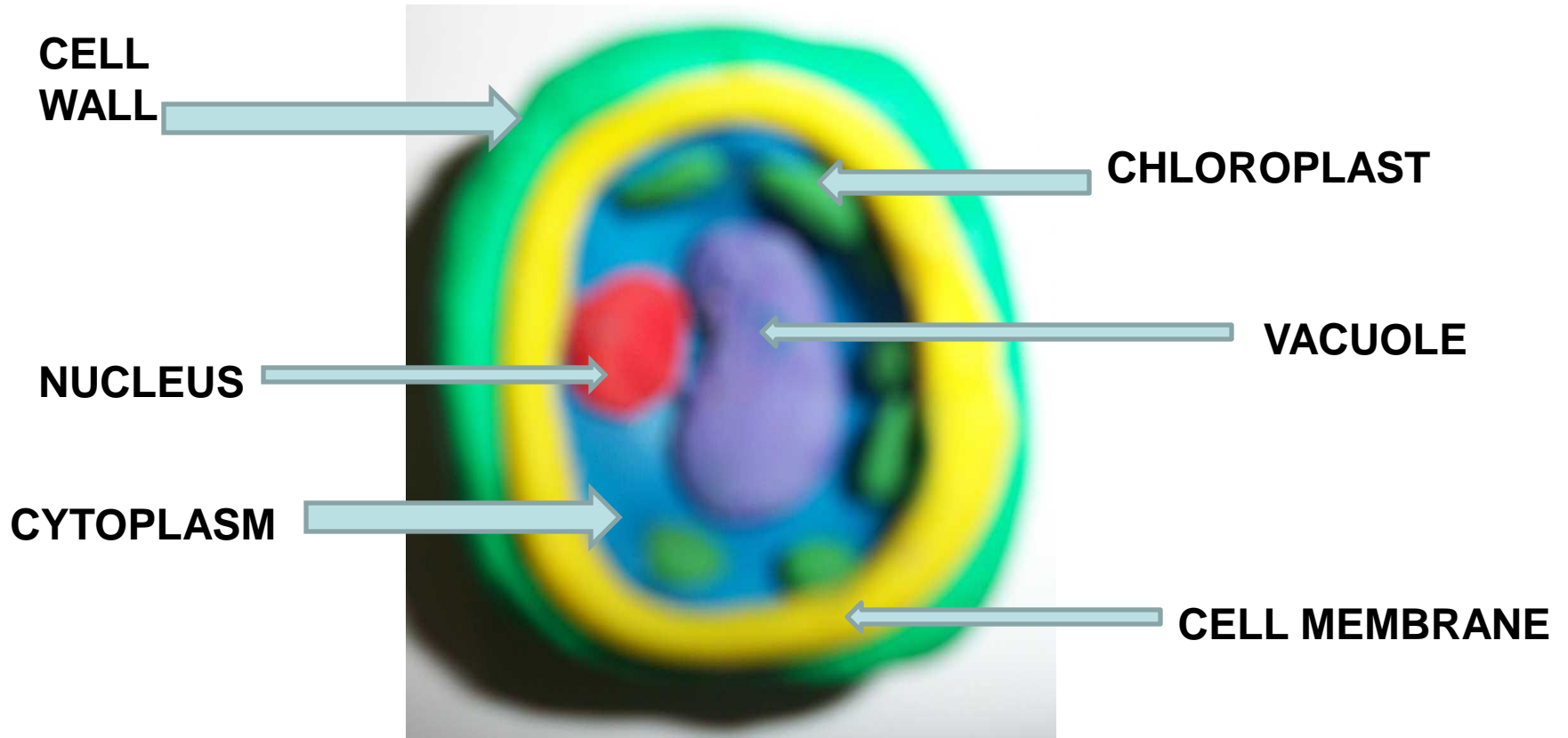

Plant cell explanation

- The rigid blue-and-white magnetic structure is the cell wall. The soft greenish-yellow magnetic sticks make up the cell membrane. The paper inside the cell membrane is the cytoplasm. In the cytoplasm are the vacuole (the smiley face) the nucleus (the pink bean) the chloroplasts (the small green sticks) and the starch grains (the grey balls)

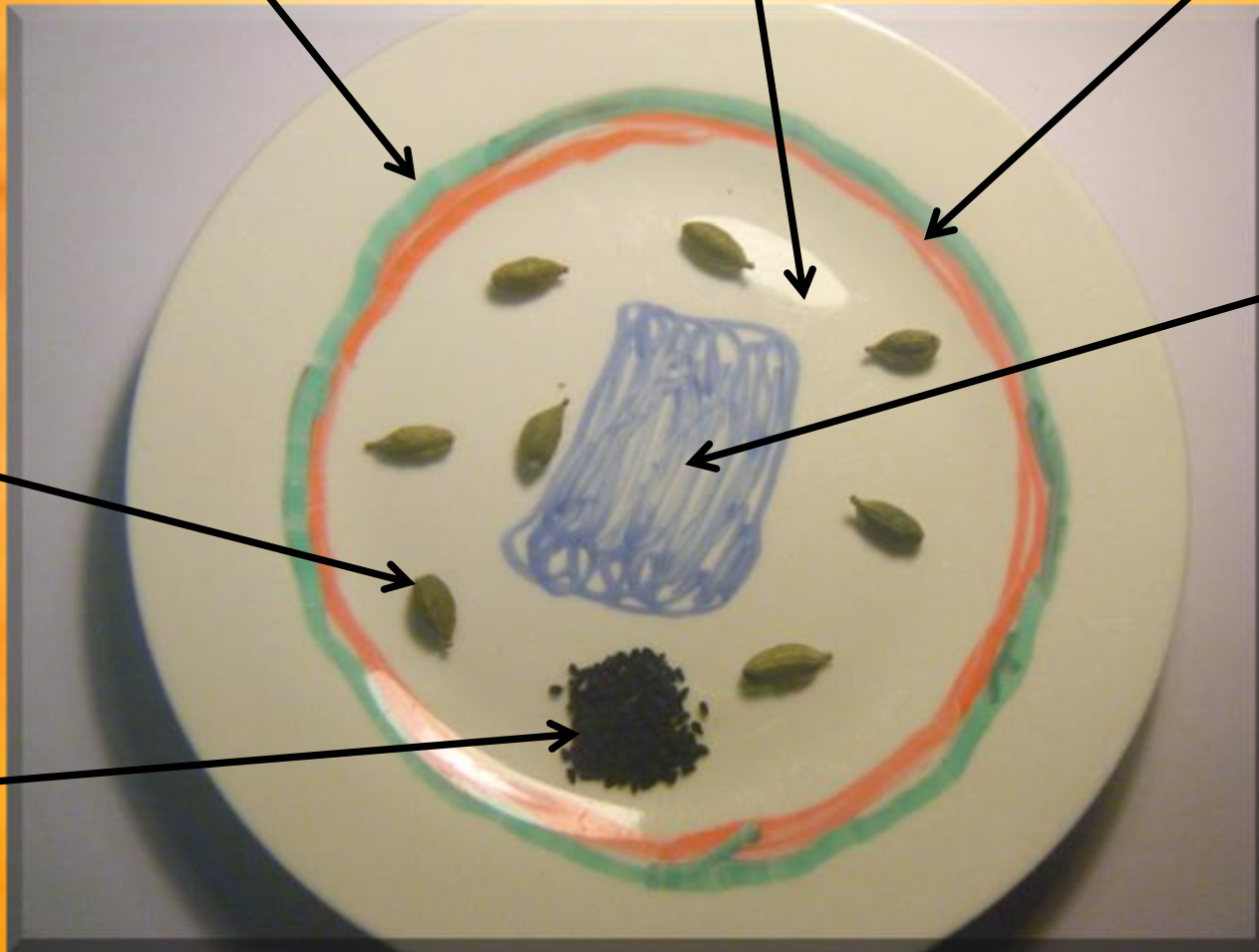
